



PARENT/GUARDIAN AGREEMENT

- A valid physical (exam dated within 3 years of camper's start date) must be provided prior to his/her first day of camp. This is required for ALL CAMPERS.
- If any medications need to be taken at camp, a Medication Authorization Form as well as an Individual Care Plan must BOTH be completed and signed by both parent and prescribing physician. Any medications must be brought to camp in their ORIGINAL BOX/CONTAINER only. Our nurse will not be able to administer medications unless all paperwork is properly submitted.
- If my child should become ill or sustain a non-emergency injury at camp, I will see that they are picked up promptly. My child must be free of symptoms such as fever, diarrhea, vomiting, etc. for 24 hours before returning to camp.
- My child has permission to participate in all age-appropriate activities at camp.
- My child has permission to use the outdoor facilities adjacent to Western Little League at 1505 West St. This includes a ninja warrior course, Nerf battlefield and bike path.
- Camp Korp reserves the right to close in the event of inclement weather. We will do our best to remain open for rain/ extreme weather days, but we may have to close for the safety of our campers and staff. Families will be notified prior and we will do our best to provide a make-up day if possible. Please be aware that this may be a possibility and prepare accordingly.
- Our goal at Camp Korp is to provide a safe, fun, accepting, encouraging & motivating environment. Any camper behavior negatively affecting others will not be accepted and depending on the severity, parents may be asked to pick up their child for the remainder of the day. Please discuss expectations with your child.
- Camp Korp is not responsible for loss of any personal belongings. Please label all of your camper's items. Found items will be placed in our Lost & Found and removed two weeks after each session.
- Cancellation of any session will result in a mandatory \$39 fee. No exceptions. Weeks may be transferred for no additional fee if space allows. Fees will not be refunded for absences. The camp director will determine refunds for unusual circumstances.
- Camp Korp may take and use photographs or videos of my child for use on website and social media, unless otherwise stated in writing.
- All campers must be signed in & out at the front desk tent. A PIN number will be assigned for each authorized pick up person that must be entered at pick-up time.
